Prior to dropping off your child at Children's Camp please:

- Encourage them to change out of "play mode" and prepare their hearts and minds to receive God's Word.
- Make sure your child is rested, fed and hydrated. This may mean that they skip an evening session to go to bed early. The adult teachings are played over speaker in Solar House for just these times!
- Take them to the restroom. Restrooms are available off the lobby of The Gathering Place.
- Apply sunscreen and bug spray.
- Make sure your child is dressed in clothes AND SHOES that can get wet, dirty or otherwise used to their fullest potential (no flip-flops, please). Please make sure each child has more than one pair of shoes packed for camp, so wet, dirty, etc. shoes can dry out if needed.

Want to help your child prepare their hearts before Camp?

- Genesis 11-22, Hebrews 11 and Romans 4 are all great reading leading up to camp, especially when I read and think about the questions:
 - What does this teach me about who God is?
 - What does this teach me about how God works?
 - How do these things change what I think and how I do things? Think of examples!
- Begin praying for Camp together
