Items To Consider Bringing

- Bibles, pens, paper/notebook
- Swimsuits:
 - Laurelville requests modesty regarding pool use:
 - Women's 1-piece or 2-piece covered with t-shirt
 - Non-Speedos for men
 - Sandals/shoes & clothing/cover-ups to/from pool
- Clothing:
 - Dress is casual
 - Remember warmer clothes for cool evenings
 - Bring enough clothing for entire week
 - Washer and Dryer use is VERY limited and is primarily for our families with young children to use as needed
- Toiletries (incl. sunscreen & insect repellent)
- Beach towel for pool
- Bedding & towels for ECONOMY housing ONLY
- K-cups for Keurig
- Teas/Hot Chocolate
- Travel coffee cup with lid, preferably spill-proof!
- Flashlight
- Cash (abundant sharing, snack shop)
- Bottled water/reusable water bottle
- Personal first aid supplies
- Fishing gear & license
- Umbrella or rain gear
- Baseball glove or any personal sports equipment
- Lawn chair
- Small lamp to use at night or a nightlight
- Fan or noise machine
- Dehumidifier (if staying in Solar)
- Ear plugs
- Small refrigerator or cooler
- Laundry supplies incl. change (50 cents a load)

Deluxe Housing: Bedding & towels provided, except pool towels.

Economy Housing: Bedding & towels NOT provided. Bring own bedding & towels (incl. pool towels). Beds are twin/single unless notified.

All housing is air-conditioned.

Refrigerators are SHARED and are located in common areas of all lodging. Rooms in Laurel Inn (Motel) have individual fridges. Consider bringing a small refrigerator or cooler for more space.

Ice is available in the center of camp by the Smoker's Pavillion – see map.

Coffee/Hot Water: Available in all of the lodging common areas (electric kettles, regular coffee pots and Keurigs). Ground coffee, filters, half & half (non-flavored), sugar/sweeteners are provided. Please bring tea, hot chocolate and/or K-cups, if needed.

Travel Cups with Lids are great to bring to camp to use in the meetings!
